

GDPR information clause regarding the processing of personal data

1. 5. Your personal data may be transferred to entities processing personal data on behalf of the administrator: IT service provider; home.pl S.A. Linuxpl.com
6. Your personal data will be stored for the duration of the legitimate interest of the administrator, unless you object to the processing of data.
7. Your data will not be transferred to a third country or an international organization.
8. You have the right to access your data and the right to rectify, delete, limit processing, the right to transfer data, the right to object, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing that was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
9. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body dealing with the protection of personal data, which is the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the Act of 10 May 2018. on the protection of personal data (consolidated text, Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1000) or the provisions of the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation) of 27 April 2016 (Journal of Laws EU.L No. 119, page 1).
10. The data you provide will not be subject to automated decision making and profiling.
